
## Artists Stand Up to Support the Legacy of the Blue Elephant and NOMA Gallery







The Baltimore Symphony Orchestra (BSO), in partnership with WYPR, a Baltimore Public Media non-profit company, will offer a pay-what-you wish family-focused performance pairing two timeless classics, *Peter and the Wolf* and *Hansel and Gretel*, at Hood College on **Saturday, January 10, 2026**. 


