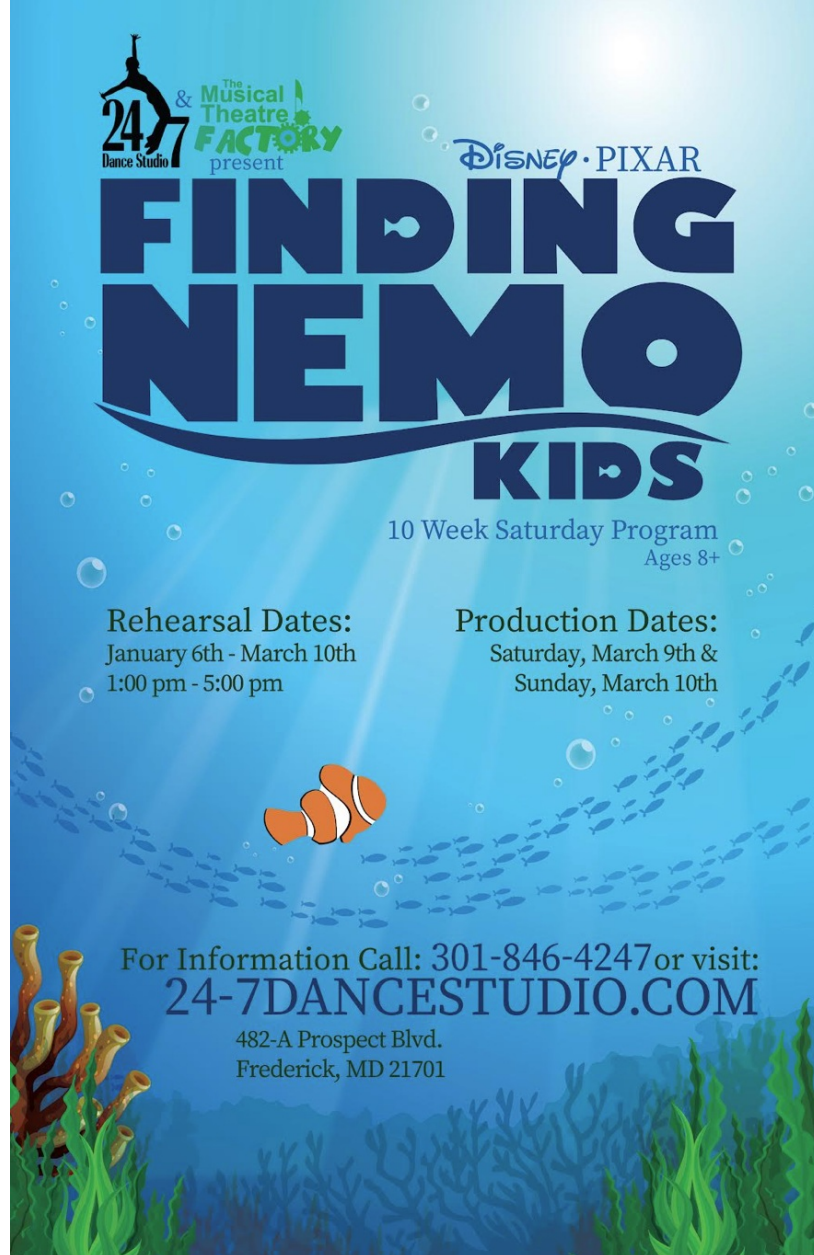

DEADLINE for SUBMISSION: FEBRUARY 1, 2024

MAD Dance invites proposals from artists (individuals or groups) to perform as part of "Intentional Terrarium." H. L. Mencken - "Baltimore-Born Journalist Extraordinaire"

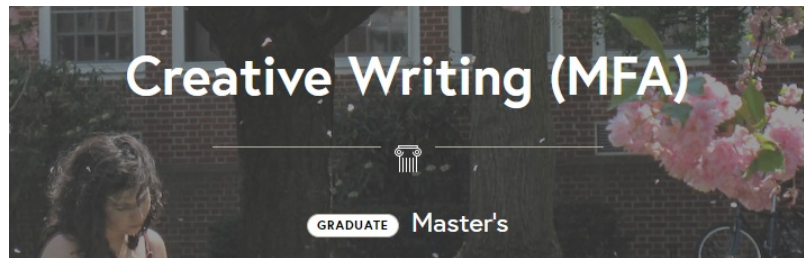

(Written by Christopher T. George) He became the outspoken and controversial face of the *Baltimore Sun*. Henry Louis Mencken (1880-1956), born in Baltimore September 12, 1880, was the son of Anna Margaret (Abbau) and August Mencken Sr., a cigar manufacturer. He was of German ancestry and spoke German as a child. At age three, his family moved to a new home at 1524 Hollins Street facing Union Square Park in West Baltimore.

Apart from five years when he was married to Alabama-born writer Sara Haardt, a Professor of English at Goucher College whom he married in 1930, Mencken would live in that same house on Hollins Street for his entire life. Tragically, because of Sara Mencken's poor health due to her having persistent tuberculosis, the marriage was doomed. She passed away from meningitis on May 31, 1935 leaving the journalist grief stricken. He would never marry again. See the 1968 book *The Constant Circle: H. L. Mencken and His Friends* written by Sara Mayfield, an

Alabama childhood friend of Mrs. Mencken's.
