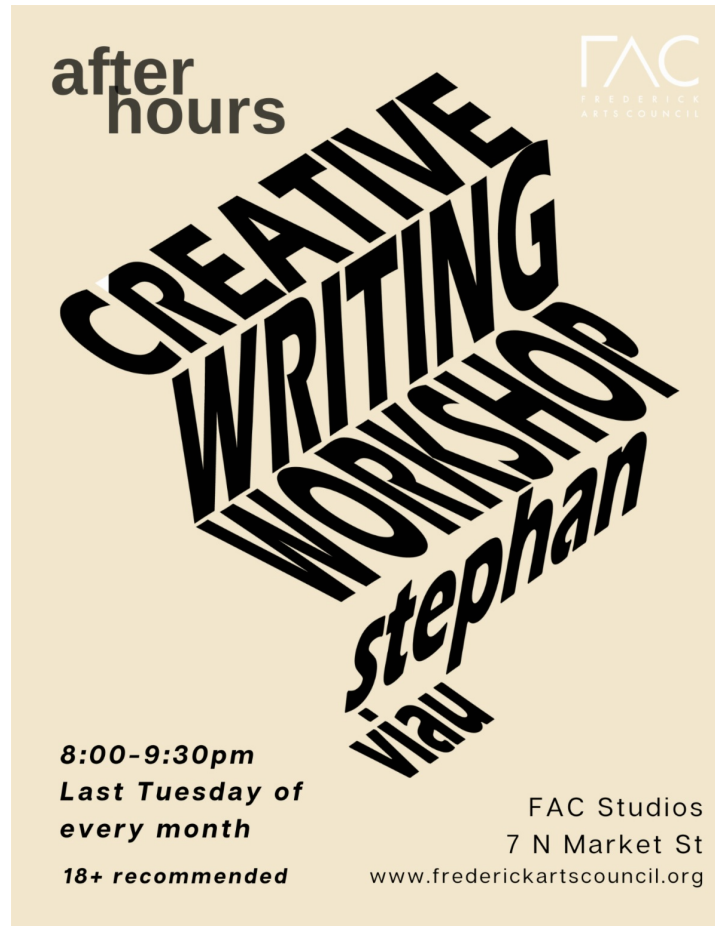

ON JANUARY 30TH BOOMTOWN Part 1 Premiered at the Warehouse Cinemas to 4 consecutive sold out audiences. Back by popular demand, BOOMTOWN will screen again:

March 6 @ 5P, 6P and 7:15P

March 16 @ 2:30P, 3:30P and 4:30P

Randall Simpson and WLR Automotive have recently announced another \$50,000. donation for the production of BOOMTOWN Part 2.

Big Blue Foundation <https://www.bigblue.foundation/> has also recently received generous funding from Visit Frederick and Dave Ziedelis and the Cross Foundation, Don and Becky Linton. The mission of Big Blue is to help keep the planet blue and make Films for the Greater Good.

All production of BOOMTOWN Part 1 is complete. \$250,000 in cash has been raised to date. Part 2 is currently in the script phase with production to begin in late April 2025 in Downtown Frederick.
