


Artist Opportunity: Artist of the Month Program with Cowork Frederick



Special events will be held during this month-long show including a live demonstration of painting flowers by Carol Cowie on Sunday March 9th from 1:30 – 2:30pm.


Deborah Lovelace Richardson will show and demonstrate the tools she uses to paint out of doors on Sunday, March 16th from 1:30 – 2:30pm.
