On January 30th BOOMTOWN Part I Premiered at the Warehouse Cinemas to 4 consecutive sold out audiences. Back by popular demand, BOOMTOWN will screen again:

Randall Simpson and WLR Automotive have recently announced another \$50,000, donation for the production of BOOMTOWN Part 2.

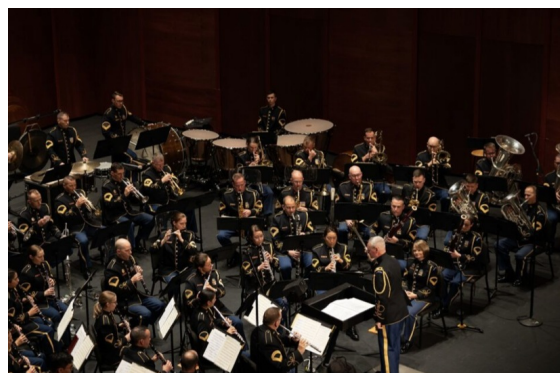

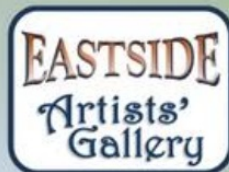

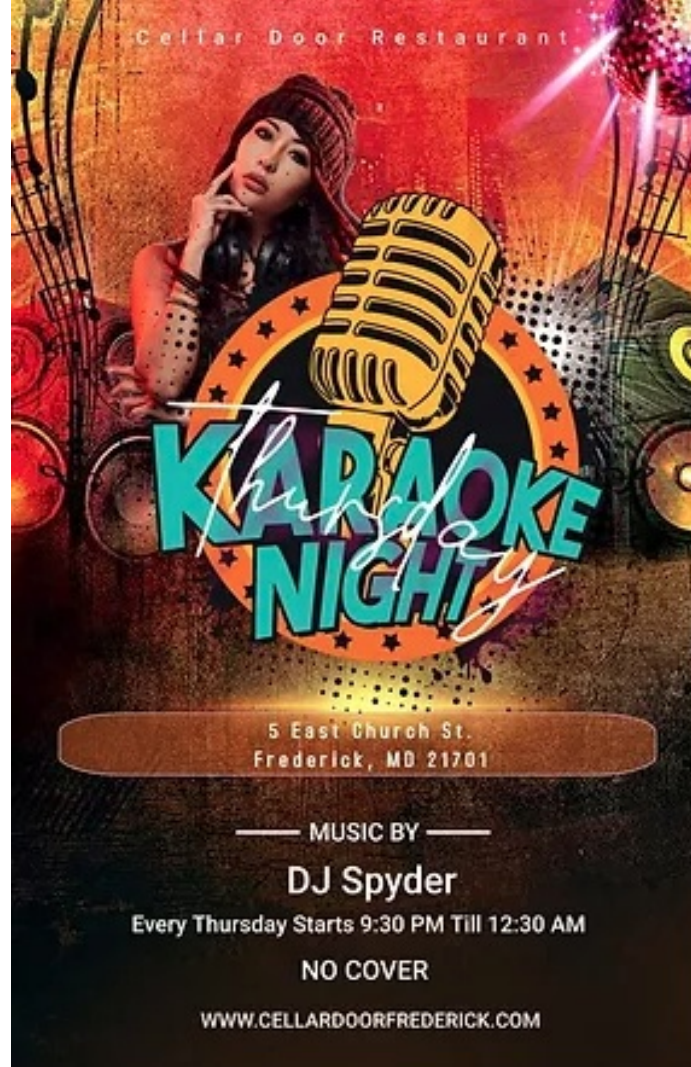
