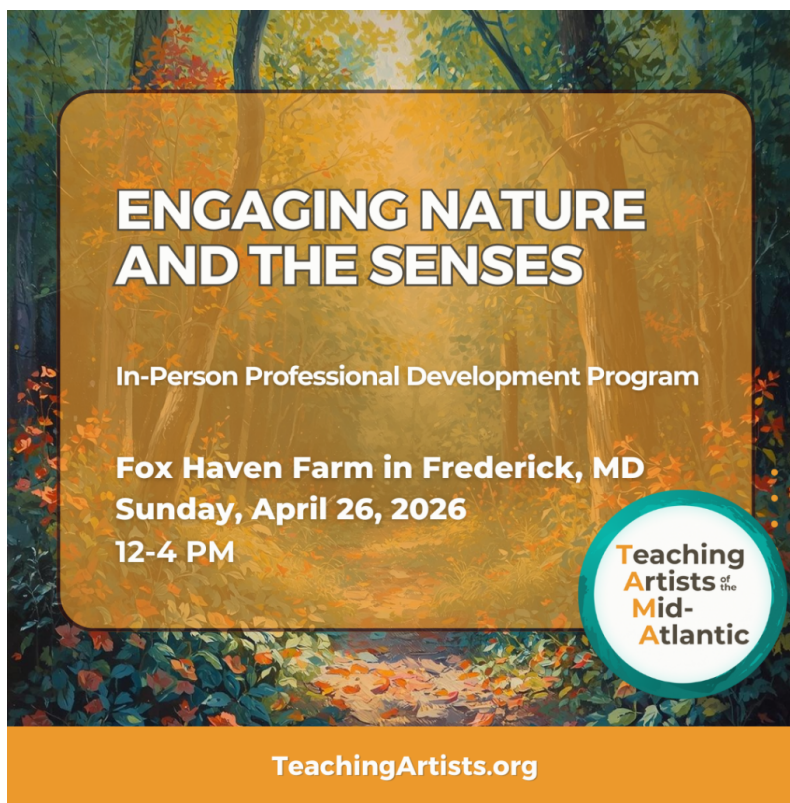

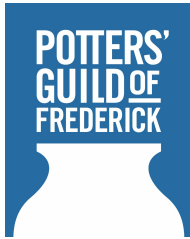


The City of Frederick Request for Proposals: Bearing Witness: Sights of Enslavement Project Proposals due April 6

The City of Frederick's **Sites of Enslavement: The Untold Histories of Frederick initiative** seeks to identify, document, and interpret the sites located in the downtown historic district that are linked to the history of slavery. We are partnering with the **African American Resources Cultural and Heritage Society (AARCH)** to share stories that have long gone untold. A [Historic Context Report](#) was completed in the spring of 2025, and serves as a foundational document to help

guide historic and artistic interpretation. The final project includes a walking tour, brochure, historic markers, online platform, and videos. The artwork is primarily needed for historic markers but may be used for other elements of the project.
