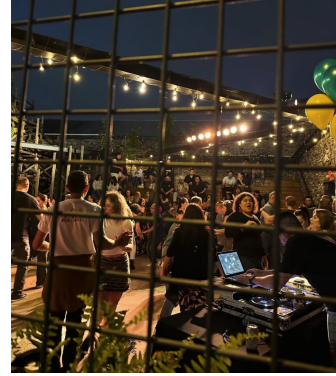

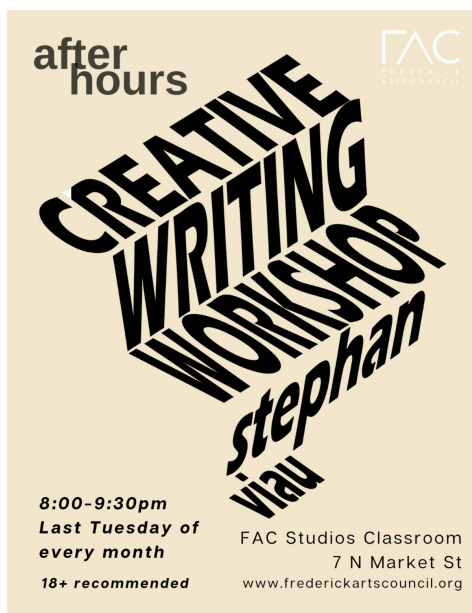

John Barth – Metafiction Master

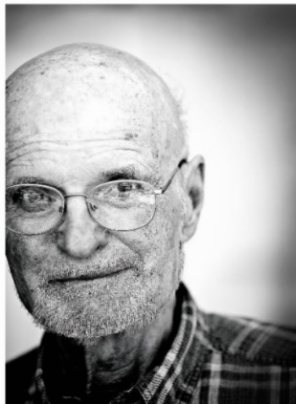


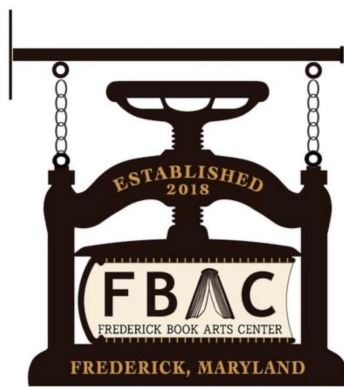

John "Jack" Barth, born in Cambridge, Maryland, on May 27, 1930, was famous in the 1960s as a writer who challenged standard conventions of language and plot. It was in the 60s that he wrote his most well known books; *The Sot-Weed Factor*, a whimsical retelling of Maryland's colonial history; *Giles Goat-Boy*, a best-selling satirical fantasy in which a university is a microcosm of the Cold War world and the hero is a character who is part goat; and *Lost in the Funhouse*, an experimental collection of short stories.

Barth graduated from Cambridge High School in 1947 where he wrote for the school newspaper. Being raised on Maryland's Eastern Shore and following the adage to write what you know, many of Barth's works take place there including *Sabbatical: A Romance* and *The Tidewater Tales*. He received a B.A. in 1951 and an M.A. in 1952, both from Johns Hopkins University.

The metafiction genre, where he undermines literary conventions, shows clearly in his novel *LETTERS* where Barth corresponds with characters from his other books. *The Tidewater Tales* and *The Last Voyage of Somebody the Sailor* are also metafiction, with writers as protagonists who interact with their own and other stories in elaborate ways.
