



"Glad to do it!" - James Burd Brewster

James Burd Brewster was born a twin, in Rochester, NY on Dec, 8, 1954. Raised in Albany, NY, he attended the USCG Academy. Assigned to Wilmington, NC after graduation, he met and married Katie Spivey and career decisions eventually deposited them in January 1987 in Baltimore, MD. It was there, in 1990 that he told Uncle Rocky - Fireman stories to his two oldest boys. His purpose was to give his boys a desire to help others, just like firemen do.

Fast forward 22 years. James and Katie moved the family to Pomfret, MD and after Sam, their youngest, left for college they took a creative writing course together at the College of Southern Maryland. During Dr. Wayne Karlan's class, the idea of making the Uncle Rocky stories into books bubbled to the surface. With the encouragement of Christina Allen, a St Marys County illustrator, and the support of Yvonne Medley's Life Journey's Writers Guild they started a publishing company and published their first Uncle Rocky – Fireman story in 2013. "Parents and kids love them," said Brewster. "Kid's enjoy the stories and parents like hearing their kids say, 'Glad to do it!' along with Uncle Rocky."


Artist Opportunity: Artist of the Month Program with Cowork Frederick

Esquivando las Miradas by Juan Santos

Juan Santos was born in the Bronx, New York City, and later lived in a community of Puerto Rican single mothers in inner city Boston. Santos earned his MFA in Visual Art at Lesley University in Cambridge, MA, and now teaches art at Boston Day and Evening Academy, an alternative high school in Boston. His students often live in dystopian worlds of their own. Using the visual language of cartoons and the street language of graffiti, Santos is able to relate to his students about contemporary fears and trauma. He uses the language of comics and the recurring image of a cartoonish bird to address the difficult themes so many young people are facing.






