Ribbon Cutting for the Brunswick Arch



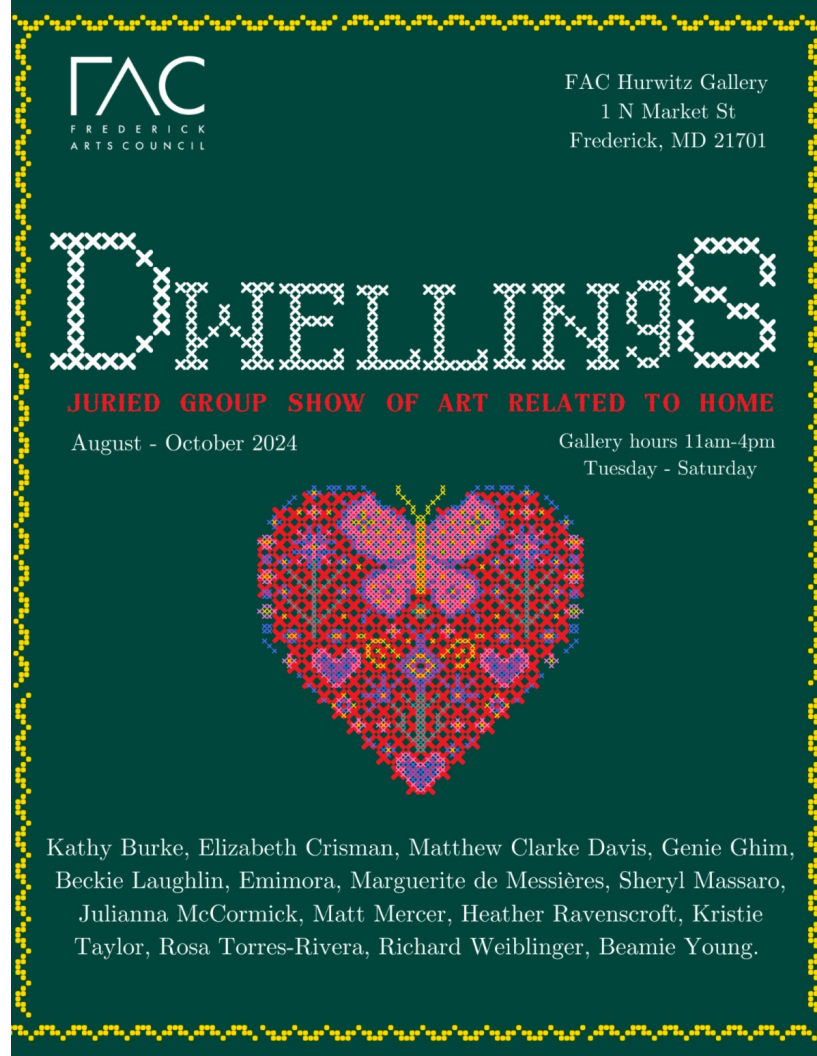
On September 6th, we celebrated the completion of the Brunswick Arch installed as an entry point of the Brunswick Train Depot at South Maple Ave.

This project was commissioned by the Frederick Arts Council and made possible by the Ausherman Family Foundation in partnership with Pleasants Construction, Inc.

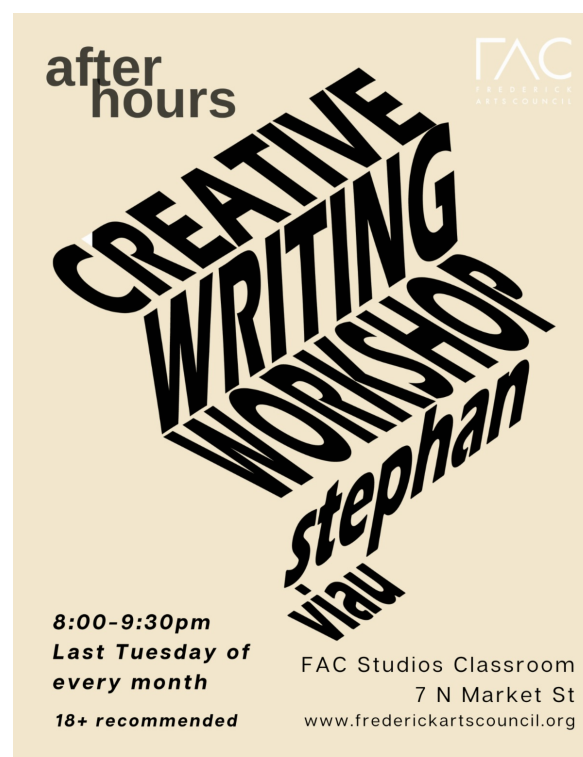

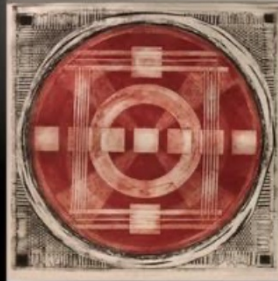


