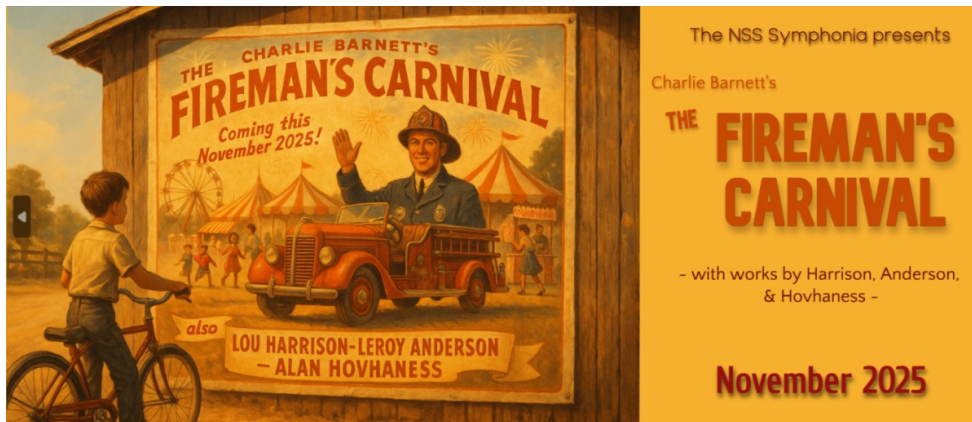


The National String Symphonia at New Spire Arts

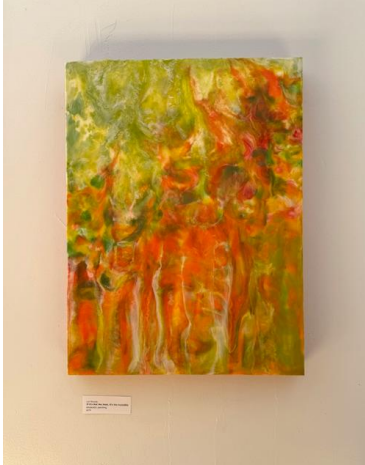

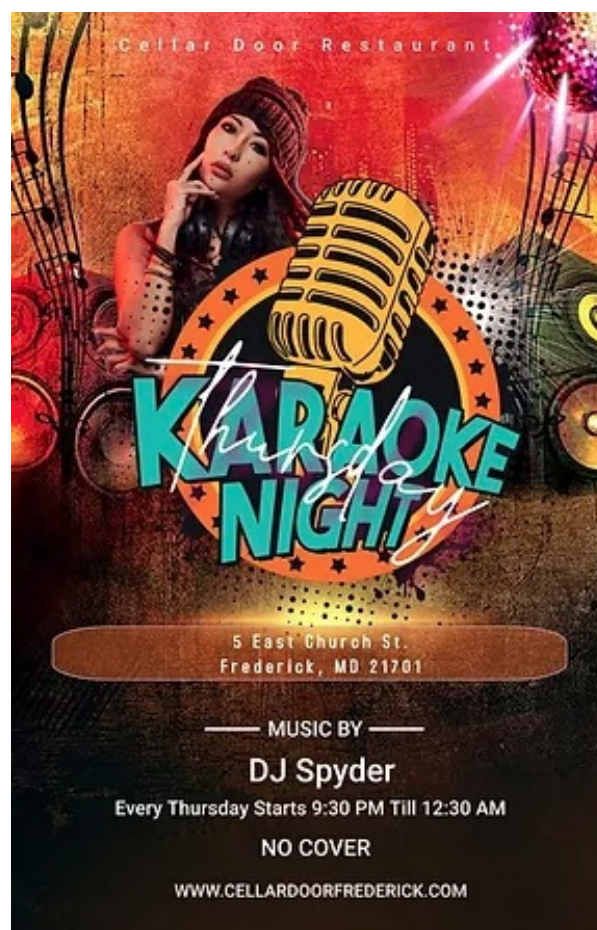
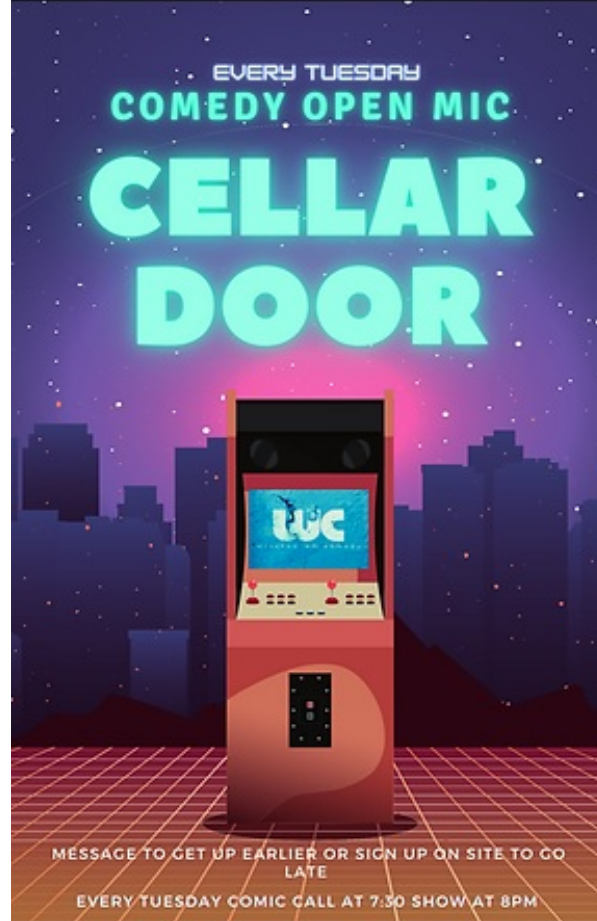
