




As part of the program, artists participate in a Frederick Artists Night (FAN) event with an exhibit and reception open to the public, along with live music from local singer-songwriters.

Cowork Frederick is particularly interested in artists who may not have had a chance to have an exhibition of their own yet.



Sea Legs by Lisa Sheirer

Lisa Sheirer has been creating art for over 40 years. She works in a wide variety of mediums. The natural world has long been the foundational concept of her work. Awareness of the flora, fauna, microflora, water, and soil comes from hiking in her neighboring watershed, the ancient Catoctin Mountains. Sheirer goes almost daily into the watershed, documenting life there. Her work concerns our local, regional, national, and world environments. Sheirer's focused study and artistic expression of our natural environment helps us gain awareness of ecological rhythms and change, as we gain our sea legs in an evolving world.

Original works from three different series are being shown for the **Sea Legs** show: "Stratum" and "Sequence" series are primarily ink paintings, "Thinking of the Future" works are collages. All are ongoing series.
