

MSAC relies on a diverse array of experts from across the state to do the important work of evaluating POL competitors' recitations. Judges are selected with a focus on diversity of experiences, diversity of location, and expertise in literary and theater arts. Judges must be Maryland residents. As part of the program, artists participate in a Frederick Artists Night (FAN) event with an exhibit and reception open to the public, along with live music from local singer-songwriters.


Cowork Frederick is particularly interested in artists who may not have had a chance to have an exhibition of their own yet.


