

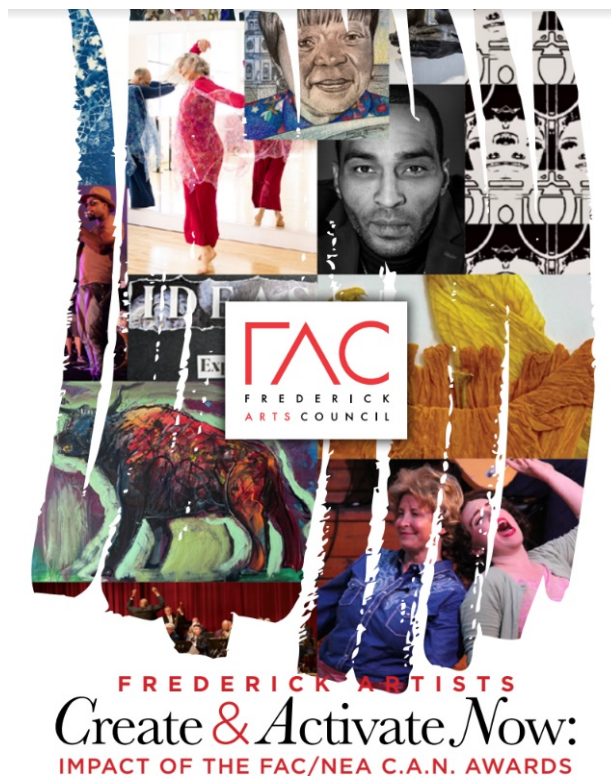

The Frederick Arts Council is pleased to invite qualified artists and artist teams to submit proposals for an exciting public art project in Downtown Frederick, Maryland. This Request for Proposals seeks innovative and engaging light installations for two distinct locations within the heart of our city – the Sky Stage and the exhibition hall of the Art Center. The project aims to enhance the cultural vibrancy and aesthetic appeal of our community by showcasing the talent and creativity of artists working with light as a medium.

REQUIREMENTS

All proposals must be submitted by December 11, 2023 at 11:59 EST. Proposals must be submitted electronically using the Slideroom application.

ELIGIBILITY

The RFP is open to artists, artist teams, and artist-led collaborations 18 or older. The Frederick Arts Council encourages local, regional, and national artists to apply. Applicants should have experience working on public art projects and be able to demonstrate their ability to complete such a project.

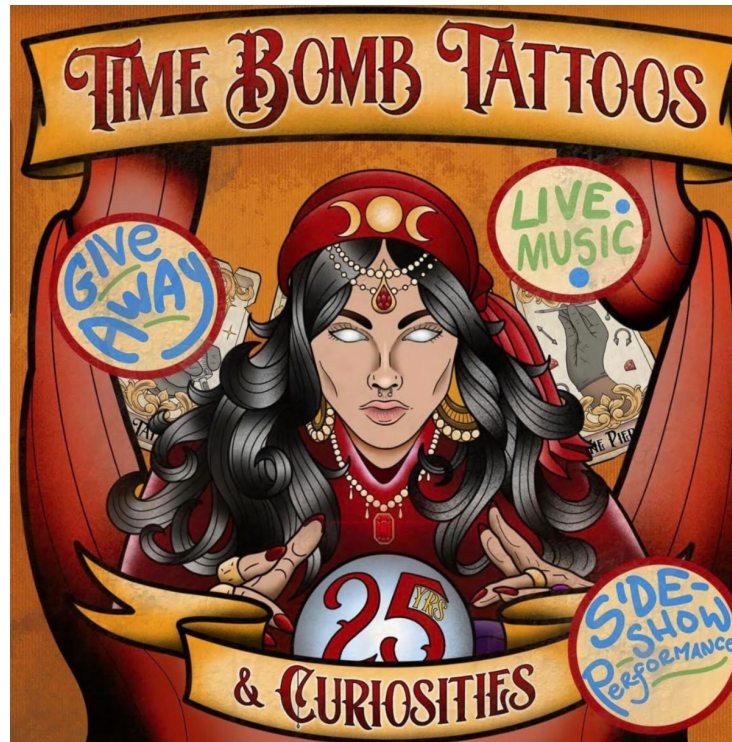

MSAC is seeking a Fiscal Officer to join the team. Duties of the Fiscal Officer include: preparation and monitoring of MSAC's operating budget and capital grant program budget request; compiling data for presentation to the agency Executive Director, Departmental Budget Analysts and Officers, and the Council; monitoring all expenditures and receipts; recommending adjustments in the budget; conducting the annual fiscal year close-out; and providing information to auditors. Incumbent is also responsible for monitoring and reporting on annual partnership application(s) to the National Endowment for the Arts; overseeing the agency's grant payment process; and managing administrative functions including all procurement contracts, facility management, inventory, requisitions, expenditures, and documentation of agency administrative and fiscal procedures. Position will monitor Arts Capital grant requisitions and expenditures and other tasks in coordination with the Board of Public Works and the Department of General Services. 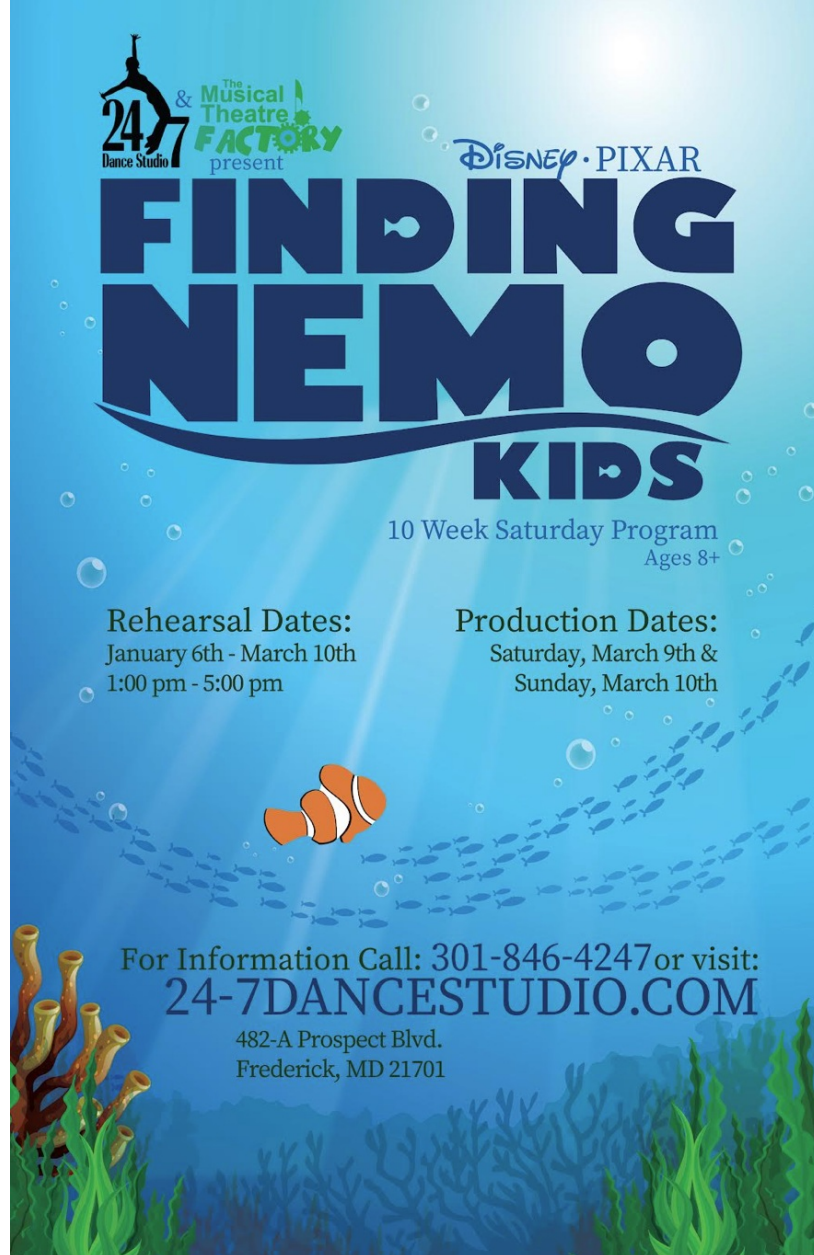

NOVEMBER 2023 NOTABLE MARYLAND AUTHORS: ROLAND FLINT

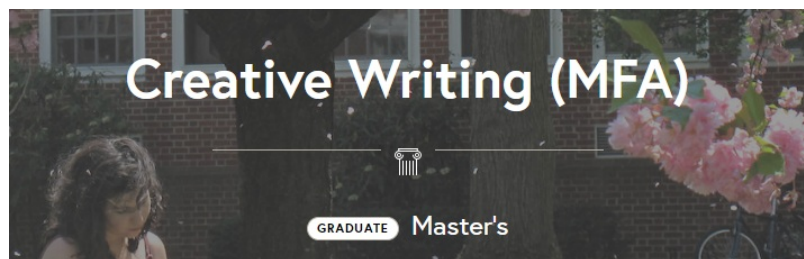
"My poems are accessible at the first level of understanding. They're user friendly." – Roland Flint

Roland Henry Flint, born February 27, 1934, was an American poet, professor of English at Georgetown University for 29 years, and Poet Laureate of Maryland. He was born in Park River, North Dakota, flunked out of the University of North Dakota, and joined the United States Marine Corps. While serving in post-war Korea he decided college would give him a better life and returned to and graduated from the University of North Dakota. This was followed by an M.A. in English from Marquette University and a Ph.D. from the University of Minnesota. It was here he began to publish his poetry.

When asked about his poetry he said, "My poems are accessible at the first level of understanding. They're user friendly." He tried to put on paper "common feelings, captured in uncommon language." Colleagues said Flint "loved to explore the frailties and surprising strengths of characters most would call 'losers,' noting the capacity for nobility in unexpected places."

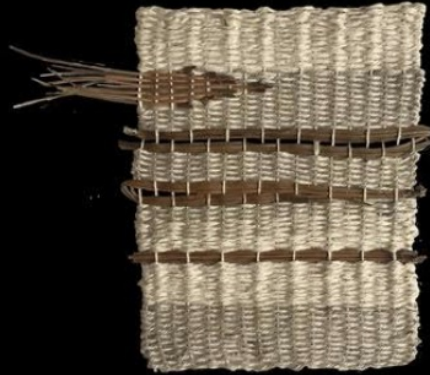

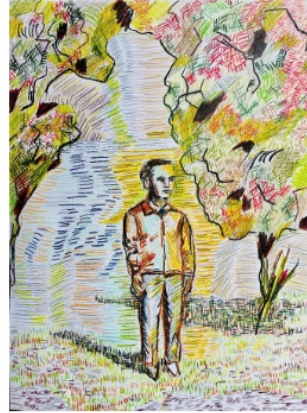

Isabel Manalo is an Artist's Artist. She is a pro who not only maintains her own studio practice and exhibition schedule, but also guides countless other artists with aesthetic and academic counsel. Manalo's paintings possess an uncommon transcendence and mysticism. Yet they are essentially simple and familiar in their subject matter, often with her two young daughters engaged in exploration and wonder amid the natural world. The jewel-like glances of vivid translucent color so musically applied to the picture plane provide a sense of hopeful providence and even joy. Manalo has been exhibiting her work internationally since 1999. Her art works are included in several public and private collections, such as the National Academy of Sciences in Washington, DC, the permanent collections of [U.S.](#) Embassies in Bulgaria, Philippines, Kazakhstan and Nepal. Manalo is currently an Adjunct Professor at [American University](#) and [George Mason University](#) and serves as an Artist Mentor at [Lesley University in Boston, MA](#). She is the Founder and Chief Collaborator of [The Studio Visit](#), an art journal featuring artist interviews with artists in their studios.

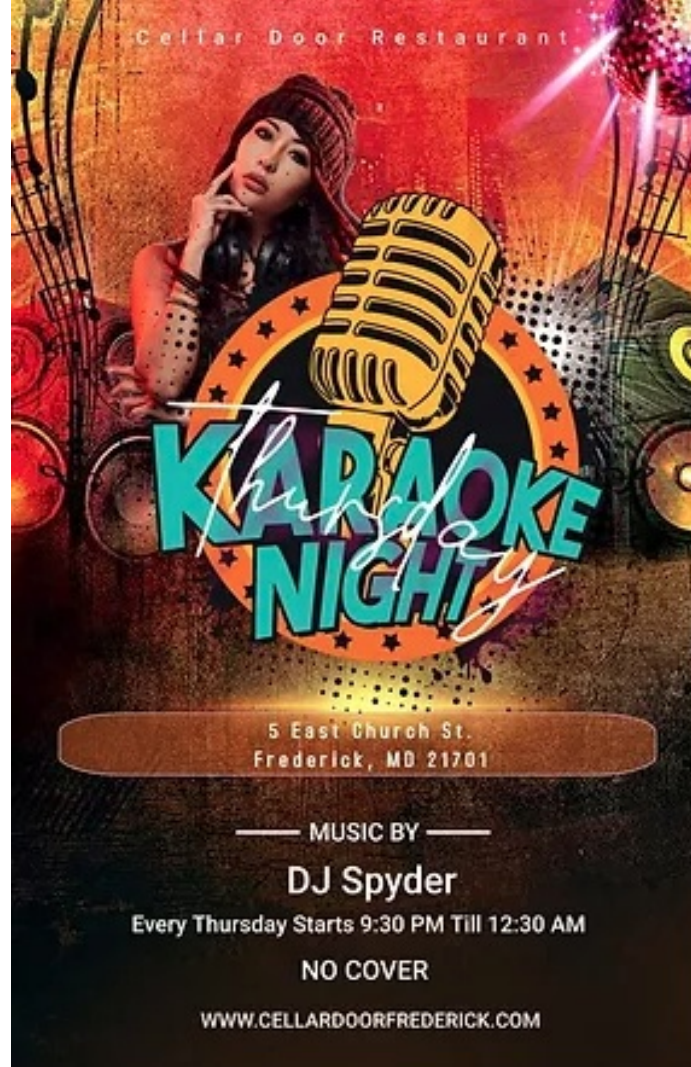
