5 & 7 N Market: Studios Space Former BB&T Bank Office Complex



Studios are available in a variety of sizes, and some come with amenities such as Market & Patrick Street square corner views and in-unit storage closets.

Currently available units are priced between \$350-\$400/month.

FAC's Sky Stage Wins 'Best Small Music Venue'







Elissa Brent Weisman is best known for her Nerd Camp series which features Gabe, a probable nerd, who has the summer of his life at camp. It's a summer filled with crazy bunkmates, a mysterious lice epidemic, a karaoke showdown, an intense Color War, and a midnight journey to Dead Man's Island.

Weissman's books have been featured in Entertainment Weekly, The Washington Post, The Los Angeles Times, The Huffington Post, NPR's "Here and Now," and more. She finally published The Ryland Revolt (first chapter only) when she included it in her anthology titled, Our Story Begins. It's a compilation of the stories that, now famous children's authors and illustrators wrote and drew when they were children.

Weissman moved away from Baltimore and currently lives in Christchurch, New Zealand with her husband and their two children.



Synonyms Judith Kornett & Julia Schrecengost

A synonym is usually defined as a word having the same meaning as another word in certain contexts. Two people can also be synonymous with each other; this is especially easy when two artists share aesthetic sensibilities and philosophies. Judith Kornett and Julia Schrecengost do indeed share these attributes as artists and friends. Kornett and Schrecengost have worked side by side in the studio for much of the past year swapping ideas, techniques, inspirations, and stories. This exhibition is the culmination of both artists' labor from this period, during which they realized they could only describe this work as a meeting of their artistic minds, an obvious synonymous connection.

Their show, entitled SYNONYMS, will include drawings, prints, and sculptures. It will be on display at NOMA Gallery, 437 N. Market St., Frederick Maryland, from December 2nd-31st. The artists' reception will be Saturday, December 3rd from 5-8 pm. There will be an artists' talk on Thursday, December 15, from 7-8 pm.


Johnny Memphis is an artist who has traveled the world as a musician, photographer, painter, journalist, teamster, and jack of all trades. He began his artistic journey busking on Beale Street in Memphis. He moved on to New Orleans, Cape Cod, and west to Los Angeles to perform in well-known clubs like The Troubadour and Gazzari's. Johnny traveled to Europe and began photographing street scenes that reminded him of his old homestead in the French Quarter of New Orleans. When he had an offer in the late '90s to move to Philadelphia, his first stop was the New Hope art colony in Bucks County, PA. During one of his musical performances, he met his muse – the late Mrs. Lilias Barger, who held weekly Grand Salons of classical music at her home in Carversville, PA. She encouraged his painting and critiqued his work until the end. His folk style of painting street scenes and theatrical venues is reminiscent of his Beale Street roots. His visions are gritty streets and splendid performance halls, extremes that converge where people gather to share and experience life.


