To the Artists & Arts Orgs of Frederick: Help is On the Way

We are thrilled to share that we are recommended for \$500,000 for subgranting to help our local arts and cultural community recover from the pandemic. The Frederick Arts Council was awarded the highest level of NEA ARP grant funding to local arts agencies along with just a few other jurisdictions including Los Angeles, Chicago, and Miami.

The National Endowment for the Arts recently announced \$20,200,000 in grant funding from the American Rescue Plan. These funds will support job creation, facilities management, health and safety supplies and promotion of events.

Upcoming Opportunity with the Mid-Atlantic Arts Foundation

The Mid-Atlantic Arts Foundation is currently accepting applications for the USArtists International grant program.

USArtists International supports performances by U.S. artists at impactful international festivals and performing arts marketplaces outside the United States and its territories. The program supports the engagements of exemplary solo artists and ensembles across all performing arts disciplines including dance,



music, theater, multidisciplinary work, and folk/traditional arts.

USArtists International is designed to encourage the presence of U.S. performing artists on international stages and in the global arts community; to support engagements that develop and expand both the careers and artistic goals of U.S. performers by providing connections with presenters, curators, and fellow artists; and to promote justice in the arts community by elevating the diverse voices contributing to the vibrant array of creative expression in the United States.

USAI provides grants of up to \$18,000 toward eligible expenses. The application deadline is December 1st.

Artist Feedback Sought through "The Future of Artist Employment in Maryland" Survey

MSAC is spending the year focusing on improving its efforts to connect Maryland artists with employment opportunities across the state. This month, make your voice heard by participating in "The Future of Artist Employment in Maryland" survey, available at <u>this link</u>.

This survey follows a series of five public dialogues MSAC hosted in September, in which artists responded to prompts about the artist employment initiative. The survey solicits responses to the same prompts. The required prompts should take about five minutes to complete. The required and optional prompts should take about twenty minutes to complete. Per request, responses logged during the September dialogues have been aggregated and published for reference. Survey respondents interested in reviewing those materials may access them at <u>this link</u>.

Responses to the survey will make up part of the data that will inform the creation of a responsive program that strives to meet the needs of Maryland's artists. The anticipated rollout of this program is summer 2022.

Author, Singer, Playwright Wows Kids with WOW Writing Formula.

Author: Mary Amato

Genre: Children's Fiction

Mary Amato is an award-winning children's and YA book author, poet, playwright, and songwriter. Her books have been translated into foreign languages, optioned for television, and produced onstage. She is the recipient of the William G. Wilson Maryland Author Award from the Maryland Library Association. Her work has also won children's choice awards in Ohio, Minnesota, Utah, and Arizona.

Mary started writing at the age of seven when they took a trip to California and her mother gave her a notebook and encouraged her to keep a journal. She discovered how enjoyable it was to record something in a journal and then be able to read it later. Her favorite books as a child were Harriet the Spy by Louise Fitzhugh because Harriet was a terrific journal keeper and Little Women by Louisa May Alcott. She still has that journal.

A renaissance woman, Mary studied special education and dance at Indiana University and completed a Masters at Johns Hopkins University with a focus on fiction writing and poetry. This smorgasboard of artistic interests percolates through her work. Mary's children's fiction includes over twenty published works, a new series launched this year, and a new picture book in 2022. She also writes personal essays for newspapers and magazines, composes poetry and songs, and sings. As co-founder of Firefly Shadow Theater, she writes plays, stories, and scripts for shows that range in size and scope and that are sometimes pure entertainment and sometimes educational.

To remain productive and reduce burn out, Mary balances each day with a mix of "seat-in-chair" writing, singing, and teaching. "I mix up the day so that one creative pursuit feeds the other. I get and give more energy this way." A typical day would start with a four hour writing block, followed by a "plot walk" (walking with a notebook in hand to generate ideas), followed by a brief singing session, and capped off with one of her online writing classes. The highlight of her week is every Friday from 1:00-1:30 PM EST when she offers on online writing session for adults writers of all genres.

"I love sharing my discoveries, trials, and triumphs with other writers." Mary especially loves showing kids they can create stories and explains it using her "WOW" formula. A character who Wants something, overcomes an Obstacle in the way, in order to Win what they wanted.

Mary, who lives in Hyattsville, MD, is in demand for school presentations and retreats on writing and the creative process as well as teaches popular online workshops. Find out more at www.maryamato.com.

Reconfigured explores the relationship between beauty and the grotesque. This juxtaposition creates a weird, cognitive dissonance that is not entirely unpleasant. The resignation that beauty is always suspect, but still must be pursued, anchors Mayes and Gill's investigation into the tension between these two aesthetics.

Themes prevalent in both artists' work include: femininity, whimsy, distortion, beauty, youth and fragility. Both artists articulate their complicated and nuanced relationships with social pressures and constructs while simultaneously navigating their journey as individuals, artists and specifically, women.
